- **TONIGHT'S KEY RUN:** The game was tied at 102 with 5.9 seconds to play. Jason Terry hit a baseline jumper with 1.4 seconds remaining to give Dallas the 2-point edge.

NOTES

- Erick Dampier returned to the lineup after missing 8 games. He finished the game with 3 points and 1 rebound in 16 minutes.
- Jason Kidd scored a season-high 22 points (8-16 FGs, 5-8 3FGs, 1-2 FTs) in 39 minutes to go with 11 assists, 6 rebounds, 4 steals and 3 blocks. The double-double is his 4th of the season (2nd with points-assists). His previous high for points was 19 vs. UTA (11/3).
- The game is the 1st of Kidd's career with at least 20 points, 10 assists, 5 rebounds, 3 steals and 3 blocks.
- Kidd's last 20-point game came last March when he had 21 points, 10 rebounds and 11 assists at GS (3/13/09). A season ago, Kidd had 5 20-point games (2-3 DAL record).
- Dirk Nowitzki extended his streak of consecutive games with 20+ points to 13 games. He finished tonight with 28 points (11-26 FGs, 1-2 3FGs, 5-5 FTs), 6 rebounds and 4 assists in 40 minutes. Nowitzki's streak of consecutive games with a block ended at 12 games.
- The Mavericks, led by Kidd's 11, dished 31 assists on 40 made field goals. Dallas improved to 8-1 when recording 25+ assists.
- Drew Gooden contributed his 5th double-double (1st off the bench) with 15 points (5-10 FGs, 5-6 FTs) and a team-best 10 rebounds in 29 minutes.
- JJ Barea added his 6th double figures game of the season with 11 points (4-10 FGs, 3-6 3FGs), 6 assists and 1 steal in 31 minutes. Barea scored all of his points in the 2nd half and 8 of them in the 4th quarter.
- Quinton Ross was moved to the Inactive List prior to tonight's game (low back tightness).
- Dallas improved to 6-3 when shooting at least 45% FG (.460, 40-87 FGs, 10-21 3FGs).
- Samuel Dalembert came down with a season-high 19 rebounds (12 DR) with 6 points, 3 steals and 3 blocks in 33 minutes. His previous high was 14 at SA (11/29).
- For the 1st time this season, 3 opposing players scored 20+ points in the same game against Dallas (Willie Green 23, Thaddeus Young and Elton Brand 21 each).
- Tonight's attendance was 19,783 fans (19,200 capacity). The Mavs have sold out 325 consecutive regular season games at AAC. Dallas currently owns the longest running sellout streak in the NBA. Dallas has sold out all 41 games in each of the past seven seasons.
