CONNECTIONS: Mavericks guard Jason Kidd and Cleveland forward LeBron James were teammates on the U.S. Sr. Men's Basketball team and won a gold medal at the 2008 Summer Olympics in Beijing, China...Head coach Rick Carlisle and Cavaliers head coach Mike Brown coached together for two seasons in Indiana when Brown was Carlisle's associate head coach and the pair won the Eastern Conference Finals in 2004...Cavaliers coach Mike Brown attended high school at Wurzburg American High School in the hometown of Mavericks forward Dirk Nowitzki...Mavericks center Drew Gooden played for the Cavaliers from 2004-2008...Mavericks forward Shawn Marion and Bulls forward Jamarion Moon played together in Miami from 2008-2009...Jamarion Moon also played in Toronto with Mavericks forward Kris Humphries from 2007-2009...Mavericks forward Tim Thomas and Cavaliers forward Anthony Parker played together in Philadelphia from 1997-99...Anthony Parker also played in Toronto with Mavericks forward Kris Humphries from 2006-2009.

FYI:

- With 2 rebounds vs. HOU (12/18), Dirk Nowitzki became the 69th player in NBA history to come down with 7,400 rebounds
- The Mavericks fell to 3-2 in overtime with a 108-116 loss vs. HOU (12/18)...Dallas has now played OT against 3 of their 4 Southwest Division opponents (except MEM)
- A season ago, Dallas played just 4 total OT games (3-1)...the last time the Mavs played at least 5 OT games was in 2005-06 (7) and prior to that they had played 6 in 1997-98
- After shooting just 16.7% (3-18 3FGs) from 3-point range in an OT win vs. CHA (12/12), the Mavericks have shot a combined 43.8% (21-48 3FGs) from 3 in their last 3 games
- Over the last 7 games, JJ Barea is shooting 54.2% (13-24 3FGs) from 3-point range
- Led by 5 players who average at least 5.7 rebounds per game, the Mavericks rank 3rd in the NBA in rebounds per game at 43.8
- The Mavericks came down with 50 rebounds for the 5th time this season vs. HOU (12/18)...it was the 1st time they lost when recording 50+ boards
- Dallas is 13-1 when outrebounding the opposition (recently: L, 50-45 vs. HOU, 12/18)
- Dirk Nowitzki has now played 866 games as a Maverick, passing Rolando Blackman for the 3rd-most in franchise history. Nowitzki trails only Derek Harper (872) and Brad Davis (883)

30TH ANNIVERSARY: The Dallas Mavericks celebrate their 30th season this year. In 29 seasons, the Mavericks have enjoyed 11 50-win seasons, 15 playoff appearances (nine consecutive), three Western Conference Finals berths and one trip to the NBA Finals.

HOME FOR THE HOLIDAYS: The Mavericks opened the season by playing 12 of their first 20 games on the road. The rest of December sees the Mavericks playing the majority of their games at home...against some of the NBA's worthiest opponents. The 12/5 game vs. ATL kicked off a string of 8 of 12 games at home between then and 12/31 at HOU. In the coming stretch, Dallas faces only Memphis (12/26) with a losing record after having defeated CHA (12/12) and NO (12/14) as the only other sub-.500 teams in the stretch – and the Mavs have already lost in Memphis. The combined winning percentage of the 5 teams Dallas will face between now and New Year's Day is 60.9% (81-52). The Mavs face only CLE (12/20) from the Eastern Conference.

FINDING HIS GROOVE: Josh Howard is averaging 15.3 points, 4.5 rebounds, 1.3 assists and 32.7 minutes off of the bench over the last 3 games after recording just 5 points in 23 minutes at MIA (12/11). Howard's 17 points vs. HOU (12/18) were his 2nd-most this season (season-high is 20 vs. PHO, 12/8). He also played a season-high 40 minutes in Friday's game.

DIFFERENT KIND OF DOUBLE-DOUBLE: Jason Kidd recorded his 3rd rebounds-assists double-double (2nd in an OT game) of the season with a season-high tying 11 rebounds (11 DR) and 10 assists with 8 points and 4 steals in 43 minutes vs. HOU (12/18). He is the only player in the NBA this season to record a double-double of this variety. Since 2006-07, there have been 18 rebounds-assists double-doubles with Kidd owning 11 of them.

DIRK GOES FOR 30/10 AGAIN: Dirk Nowitzki turned out his 4th 30-point/10-rebound effort of the season with game-highs of 35 points (13-18 FGs, 2-2 3FGs, 7-8 FTs) and 11 rebounds in 39 minutes at OKC (12/16). Dallas is 4-0 in those games. In the 2009 calendar year, Nowitzki has the 4th-most 30/10 games in the NBA and the 2nd most in the 2009-10 season.

NOWITZKI EFFICIENCY: Dirk Nowitzki's 35 points at OKC (12/16) came on a very efficient 72.2% (13-18 FGs, 2-2 3FGs) from the floor. The game was the 2nd of the season for Nowitzki in which he scored at least 30 while shooting at least 71% FG (also 31, 10-14 FGs, .714 at IND 11/27). Nowitzki is the only player in the league to have multiple games of 30 points on 70% FG. There have been 11 such games total this season. He is also the only player this season to record a double-double in games where he has 30 points and shoots 70% FG.

ANOTHER NIGHT OF 90: For the 5th time this season, the Mavericks shot 90% from the free throw vs. NO (12/14). Dallas made 12 or their 13 attempts (.923) led by 3 each from Josh Howard and Jason Terry. The Mavs are 3-2 when shooting such a high percentage from the line and have the most games at 90+ percent. POR (3-1), HOU (2-2) and NY (2-2) are the only other teams to have 3+ such games.

LUCKY #13: Jason Kidd dished 13 assists in a game for the 3rd time this season vs. NO (12/14). He added 13 points for his 4th points-assists double-double (6th overall) of the year. Kidd is 1 of 4 players to record 3 13-assist games this season.

JJ EXCELLENTE: JJ Barea is making his case to stay in the starting lineup next to Jason Kidd. In a starting role that has now lasted 6 straight games, Barea has recorded 2 20-point games (9 for career) and has dished 6+ assists in 3 of those contests. As a starter, Barea is averaging 15.2 points and 4.3 assists after recording a season-high tying 23 points vs. HOU (12/18). For the season, Barea has 12 games with 4+ assists and 11 10-point outings. He averages career highs of 9.7 points, 2.4 rebounds, 4.0 assists and 24.4 minutes.

CLOSE CALL: Dallas is 8-1 in games decided by 5 points or less. Recently, the Mavs defeated NO (12/14) 94-90 for their 8th such victory. Dallas' only loss in this situation came to ATL (75-80) on 12/5. Dallas has won its last 3 home games by a combined 6 points. Since naming Rick Carlisle head coach, the Mavericks are 26-6 in games decided by that margin.

PLETHORA OF POINTS: Dirk Nowitzki has scored 705 points through 27 games this season and has the 3rd most behind DEN's Carmelo Anthony (814) and CLE's LeBron James (777). Nowitzki, who owns the NBA's 6th-highest scoring average, poured in his 9th 30-point game of the season at OKC (12/16). Nowitzki scored a game-high 35 points (13-18 FGs, 2-2 3FGs, 7-8 FTs) including 24 in the 2nd half. A season ago, Nowitzki had 26 30-point games, tying his career high (also 2005-06). He is on pace for around 27 30-point games this season.

FAULTLESS 4TH: Dirk Nowitzki has been perfect from the free throw line in the 4th quarter and overtime (3 games). Nowitzki is 55-55 from the line (4-4 in OT) down the stretch. Dating back to the late 4th quarter vs. NO (4/10/09), Nowitzki has made 62 consecutive FTs down the stretch.

PRISTINE 15: Dirk Nowitzki recorded his 19th 15-point half of the season at OKC (12/16) with 24 points in 20 2nd half minutes. For the season, Nowitzki has 5 20-point performances in a half – all of which have come after halftime. In halves when Nowitzki scores 15+, he shoots a combined 54.3% (125-230 FGs) from the floor, 50.0% (10-20 3FGs) from 3 and 91.4% (96-105 FTs) from the line.

BOUNCING BACK: Since the 2000-01 season (1st of 9 consecutive 50-win seasons), the Mavericks have suffered just 52 losses (in 765 games) of 15+ points. Two of those losses have come this season (82-98 at MEM, 12/4). What's more impressive though, is that the Mavs have won 38 of the games following their 15-point losses (38-14, .731). This season, Dallas is 1-1 in games following 15-point losses. Dallas has lost back-to-back by at least 15 just once in that span (2001-02 season).

HOT SHOT: Dallas poured in another great shooting effort vs. NO (12/14). The Mavericks, for the game, shot 55.1% (38-69 FGs) from the floor for the game. Dallas now owns 3 of the top 15 shooting games of the season, including the 2 highest. The Mavs shot 65.5% (55-84 FGs) from the floor at HOU (11/25), 62.4% in a win vs. TOR (11/7) and 58.7% (44-75 FGs) in another win at NJ (12/2). A season ago, DAL just reached the 60% mark at MIA on 1/31/09 (.603). The last the time Mavs had shot that high a clip was when they went 67.7% vs. San Diego Clippers in 1983. The Mavericks are 6-0 when shooting at least 50% FG.

JET & COMPANY: The Mavericks reserves rank 5th in the NBA in points per game (37.6). Jason Terry contributed his 6th 20-point game off the bench at CLE (11/28) and has single-handedly outscored the opposing bench 5 times this season (2-3 record, recently: 11-7 vs. CHA, 12/12). JET is 1 of 4 reserves to have at least 6 20-point games off the bench this season. Terry has scored the most points of any player off the bench (449) and his 16.7 ppg ranks 2nd among all bench players. JJ Barea (7th at 3.9) and Terry (10th, 3.4) both rank in the top 10 assists leaders off the bench.

He finished the OT thriller with a season-high 41 points (15-29 FGs, 1-1 3FGs, 10-12 FTs) in 45 minutes. Nowitzki is 1 of 7 players in the NBA to have multiple 40-point games. There have been 27 40-point outings this season.

IN SPITE OF THE RIM: The Mavericks are 7-5 when shooting less than 44% FG (recently, L vs. HOU, 12/18). A season ago, Dallas was 6-24 when shooting less than 44%. Dallas also has an NBA-best 4 wins when shooting 40% or less FG (4-4 overall; W vs. CHA, 12/12). Dallas won just 1 of 13 games last season when shooting 40% or worse.

MOVING UP THE RANKS: Jason Terry now has 6,879 points as a Maverick and has moved into 7th place all-time among Mavs, passing Sam Perkins (6,766) with 18 points at NJ (12/2). Terry now trails Mavericks player development coach Brad Davis, one of only two players to have his jersey retired by the franchise, for 6th place. If JET sustains his 16.6 points per game pace, look for him to overtake Davis (7,623) by the end of the season.

CRASHING THE BOARDS: Erick Dampier had a monster night on the boards vs. HOU (11/10), coming down with 20 rebounds and a career-high 17 defensive rebounds. The game marked the 8th of his career (2nd with the Mavs) with 20+ rebounds. He has 32 14-rebound performances (5 this season) since joining the Mavs in 2004-05 (recently: 14 vs. HOU, 12/18). Dallas is 22-10 when he has 14+ rebounds. Dampier had 6 games with 14+ a season ago.

IRON ERICK: Erick Dampier recorded his 6th double-double of the season with 14 points and 18 rebounds in 40 minutes vs. CHA (12/12). In 2008-09, Dampier had 6 double-doubles for the entire season. When Damp scores 10+ points, odds usually favor the Mavs. Since his arrival in Dallas (2004-05 season), Dampier has recorded 49 double-doubles (38-11 record, .776). When the center scores 10+ points, Dallas is 74-19 (.796). Over the past 4 seasons, Dampier has missed 16 regular season games – including the 8 this season due to an illness.

DIRK and KIDD FOR 3: For his career, Dirk Nowitzki has 1,100 3-pointers and ranks 43rd all-time among NBA players (need 4 3s to overtake Latrell Sprewell for 42nd). In fact, Nowitzki (7,400 rebounds) and teammate Jason Kidd (1,538 3FGs, 7,561 rebs) are 2 of only 3 players in NBA history to have at least 1,000 3s and 7,000 rebounds (also BOS Rasheed Wallace, 1,019 3s and 7,092 rebounds).

APPROACHING 20K: Dirk Nowitzki leads the Mavericks in scoring and ranks 2nd in rebounding this season. After crossing the 19,000 career point mark late last season, Nowitzki is rapidly approaching 20,000 points. Nowitzki now has 19,789 total points. He joins 45 other players to reach the 19,000-point mark and now ranks 34th all-time among NBA scorers, passing John Stockton (19,711) with 36 points vs. CHA (12/12). Stockton was the last player standing between Nowitzki and 20,000 points. Nowitzki ranks 6th among active players in all-time scoring behind Shaquille O'Neal, Kobe Bryant, Allen Iverson, Kevin Garnett and Ray Allen. Nowitzki is followed by Tim Duncan (19,668) and Paul Pierce (19,044).

CLUTCH: Dirk Nowitzki was once again the hero for the Mavericks vs. CHA (12/12) as he boosted them in overtime. Despite struggling from the field throughout the game, the German scored a 6-0 run over the last 1:20 of regulation to force the extra 5:00. Then, with 1.7 seconds remaining in OT, Nowitzki hit a 10-foot fade away to secure the win. The game-winner is Nowitzki's 2nd of the season (also in OT at MIL, 11/16) and the 8th of his career when there are less than 5 seconds remaining. Since 2005-06, Nowitzki owns the most game-winners (put team ahead for good in final 2 seconds) of any player in the NBA. He is followed by MIA's Dwyane Wade (5) and 8 players with 4 each.

TOE THE LINE: The Mavericks, perennially one of the NBA's best free throw shooting clubs, are shooting 80.5% (498-619 FTs) from the line and rank 2nd in the NBA behind DEN. Since the 2000-01 season (first of 9 consecutive 50-win seasons), the Mavericks have shot an NBA-best 80.3% from the line, have led the league in FT shooting in 4 of those seasons (2001-02, 2002-03, 2003-04, 2007-08) and have finished in at least the top 6 each year. In that span, Dirk Nowitzki has shot 87.8% FT (7th in NBA) and has hit 4,543 FTs (4th).

WHAT A FLIRT: Jason Kidd is flirting with his 1st triple-double of the season (currently he has 103 for career trailing Oscar Robertson's 181 and Magic Johnson's 138). The point guard has 7 double-doubles and has fallen just short of a triple-double in 5 contests.

ALL ALONE IN SECOND PLACE: Jason Kidd now ranks 2nd all-time among the NBA's career assist leaders (10,447 assists). With 7 assists at HOU (11/25/09), he passed Mark Jackson (10,334) for 2nd position. More specifically, Kidd dished his 10,335th assists on an alley-oop lob to rookie Rodrigue Beaubois with 10:52 to play in the 3rd quarter of the HOU game. Kidd now trails only John Stockton (15,806). For the season, the guard averages 9.2 assists (5th among NBA leaders).

STOLE THE SHOW: With 2,248 steals, Jason Kidd now ranks 6th on the NBA's all-time steals list. With 2 steals at SA (11/11/09), Kidd surpassed Clyde Drexler (2,207). The point guard is 60 steals away from taking 5th position from Scottie Pippen (2,307).

TOP 10 LIST: Jason Kidd hit 1 3-pointers vs. ATL (12/5) to move into 8th place all-time on the NBA's 3-point field goals made list with 1,529 (surpassing Nick Van Exel, 1,528 3FGs). For his career, he has 1,538 3-pointers. With 5 more 3-pointers, he will move into 7th place (Tim Hardaway, 1,542). He can be found on several other NBA Top 10 lists (2nd at 10,447 career assists, 6th at 9.2 apg; 3rd with 103 triple-doubles; 6th with 2,248 steals).

A STRING OF STARTS: Jason Kidd has the 7th-most starts in NBA history and has started 98.9% (1121-1134) of the games he has played. Only 2 other players with 1,000 career games have started a higher percentage than Kidd (Karl Malone: 99.7%, 1471-1476; Shaquille O'Neal: 99.2%, 1129-1138). Kidd ranks 39th in career games.

BACK-TO-BACK IT UP: Dallas finished the 8th of 20 back-to-backs vs. CHA (12/12). The Mavericks have 4 more back-to-backs than last year. Seven begin on the road and conclude at home, seven are on the road and six are home-away. Twelve of Dallas' back-to-backs occur in the first half of the season. Dallas is 6-2 in the first game of a back-to-back and 4-4 in the second game.

DOUBLE-DOUBLES ADDING UP: Since the 2003-04 season, both Dirk Nowitzki and Shawn Marion are among the NBA's leaders in double-doubles. With 8 this season, Nowitzki ranks T-18th in the NBA.

HOW THE MAVS WERE BUILT: Of the 15 players currently on the roster, 11 are former first round draft picks (Erick Dampier, Drew Gooden, Josh Howard, Kris Humphries, Jason Kidd, Shawn Marion, Dirk Nowitzki, Jason Terry, Tim Thomas, Shawn Williams, Rodrigue Beaubois). Seven were top 10 picks (Dampier, Gooden, Kidd, Marion, Nowitzki, Terry, Thomas). Kidd holds the honor of being the highest drafted Maverick (second overall by Dallas in 1994). Four Mavericks were undrafted (J.J. Barea, Matt Carroll, Quinton Ross, James Singleton).

EVERYTHING IS BIGGER IN TEXAS: On 10/30/08, Dallas was awarded the 2010 NBA All-Star Game (Feb. 14, 2010). In a joint venture between Mavericks owner Mark Cuban and Dallas Cowboys owner Jerry Jones, and following the mantra that "everything is bigger in Texas," the All-Star Game will be played at the new Dallas Cowboys Stadium in Arlington, which will have a seating capacity of over 80,000 fans. This collaboration between the NBA, and the ownership groups of the Mavericks and Cowboys, will afford Mavericks season ticket holders a chance to partake in the NBA All-Star Game. The T-Mobile Rookie Challenge and NBA All-Star Saturday Night will take place at American Airlines Center. Dallas last hosted All-Star festivities in 1986.

ELITE COMPANY: The Mavericks are just the fourth franchise (five times total) since the NBA went to an 82-game schedule in 1967 to have at least nine consecutive 50-win seasons. Here is a run down of the teams to accomplish this feat:

1. Los Angeles Lakers 12 consecutive seasons (from 1979-80 to 1990-91)
2. Boston Celtics 10 consecutive seasons (from 1958-59 to 1967-68)
San Antonio Spurs 10 consecutive seasons (from 1999-00 to 2008-09)
3. Boston Celtics 9 consecutive seasons (from 1979-80 to 1987-88)
Dallas Mavericks 9 consecutive seasons (from 2000-01 to 2008-09)

JUST THE TWO OF US: The Mavericks and Spurs are the only two teams to have won 50+ games in each of the past nine seasons. Here's a look at the records of the Mavericks and Spurs over the past nine seasons:

20,000 MANIAACS: The Mavericks have sold out 330 consecutive home games, which is an NBA-best sellout streak. The listed capacity for AAC is 19,200 but that can be surpassed because of attendance in the suites. The streak started on 12/15/01. Dallas has sold out an additional 44 playoff games during that same stretch. Since moving into American Airlines Center (2001-02 season), the Mavericks have posted a home mark of 272-66 (.805). Dallas has sold out all 41 games in each of the past seven seasons.

HEAD COACH RICK CARLISLE

Regular Season Coaching Record: 350-250 (.583); Playoff Coaching Record: 35-37 (.486)

Rick Carlisle became the ninth coach in franchise history on May 9, 2008. He joined the Mavericks after spending six seasons, with Detroit and Indiana, as a head coach. Most recently, Carlisle served as an ESPN studio analyst during the 2007-08 NBA season.

In seven seasons as a head coach, Carlisle has led his team to the postseason on six occasions.

Carlisle began his head coaching career with Detroit. During his two-season tenure, the Pistons won 61.0% of their games (100-64) to go with two Central Division championships and one trip to the Eastern Conference Finals. Following his first season as head coach, Carlisle earned the NBA's Coach of the Year award in 2002.

Carlisle joined Indiana as head coach on Sept. 2, 2003. In his first year, Carlisle led the Pacers to the NBA's best record (61-21), the most victories in franchise history, the best winning percentage in franchise history and a Central Division championship. He also led the Pacers to the 2004 Eastern Conference Finals where they eventually lost to the Pistons. Carlisle, including his previous two seasons with Detroit, became the first coach since Pat Riley to win 50 games and division championships in each of his first three seasons as head coach. Overall, Carlisle earned a 181-147 (.552) regular season record in Indiana and led the team to three consecutive postseason appearances before stepping down following the 2006-07 campaign.

Carlisle began his coaching career in 1989 as an assistant with the New Jersey Nets. In five seasons with the Nets, he had the opportunity to work under Hall of Fame coaching legends Bill Fitch and Chuck Daly. Carlisle then moved on to Portland, where he spent three seasons as an assistant under P.J. Carlesimo before joining former teammate Larry Bird's staff in Indiana during the summer of 1997.
