SEASON NOTES

CONNECTIONS: Mavericks athletic trainer Casey Smith and Rockets athletic trainer Keith Jones worked together on the athletic training staff for the U.S. Sr. National Basketball program over the last three summers (2006 World Championships, 2007 Olympic Qualifying, 2008 Summer Olympics)...Mavericks center Drew Gooden and Rockets forward Shane Battier played together in Memphis for 2002-2003.

FYI:

- Dallas won in DEN (12/27) for the 1st time since 12/31/06 – in those nearly 3 years, Dallas had lost 4 consecutive regular season games and 3 more postseason contests. The drought was the Mavs’ longest on the road. With the win at Pepsi Center out of the way, Dallas will look to win in BOS for the 1st time since 3/23/07 and the 1st time against the Hornets since 3/27/07 (in Okla. City)
- Over the last 2 games, the Mavericks are shooting 51.2% (84-164 3FGs) from the floor while allowing their opponents shoot 41.2% (73-177 FGs) from the field
- Jason Terry has dished 4+ assists in 5 of his last 6 games, including 5 each over the last 2 wins. In that span, he averages 4.2 assists
- For the season, Dallas’ defense holds opponents to 43.7% from the field which is the 3rd-lowest percentage in the NBA (LAL .430, CLE .433)
- With a 13-point, 11-rebound double-double at DEN (12/27), Dirk Nowitzki recorded his 10th double-double (team-high)
- Jason Kidd is 1 of 7 players to have 6+ points-assists double-doubles this season (PHO Nash leads league with 18 followed by BOS Rondo 14, UTA Williams, NO Paul 11, CLE James 8, LAC Davis 7)
- Dallas is 14-1 when outrebounding the opposition (recently: W, 51-45 at DEN, 12/27)...in the DEN game, Dallas also improved to 5-1 when coming down with 50+ boards
- Dirk Nowitzki has now played 869 games as a Maverick and has passed Rolando Blackman for the 3rd-most in franchise history. Nowitzki trails only Derek Harper (872) and Brad Davis (883)
- The Mavs will next be in action at the AAC on Jan. 5 vs. Detroit at 7:30 p.m. on FSSW. For ticket information: mavs.com or 214-747-MAVS

30TH ANNIVERSARY: The Dallas Mavericks celebrate their 30th season this year. In 29 seasons, the Mavericks have enjoyed 11 50-win seasons, 15 playoff appearances (nine consecutive), three Western Conference Finals berths and one trip to the NBA Finals.

ON THE ROAD AGAIN: Dallas continues a string of 4 straight road games (started 12/27 at DEN) tonight in HOU – and sees 3 of last season’s Western Conference playoff teams (DEN, HOU, LAL 1/3) in that span. The Mavericks’ 11 road wins are the most by any team in the West and the 3rd-most road wins in the NBA (BOS 13, CLE 12). With 22 total victories, the Mavericks have the 4th-most wins in the NBA behind LAL’s and CLE’s 25, BOS’s 23. ORL also has 22 Ws.

OUT OF LINE: Dirk Nowitzki has not attempted a free throw in either of Dallas’ last 2 wins. A season ago, Nowitzki attempted at least 1 FT in every game and didn’t make a free throw in just 1 contest (vs. SAC, 2/21/09). The current pair of games marks the 1st time since 2003-2004 that he has not attempted an FT in consecutive games (1/31/04 vs. DEN, 2/3/04 vs. GS). There have only been 8 such instances in his entire career and he has never gone 3 straight games without attempting a free throw. For his career, the power forward averages 6.5 free throw attempts per game. This season, Nowitzki ranks T-7th in the league in FTM (188), 9th in FTA (214) and 6th in FT% (.879).

GOODEN PLENTY: Drew Gooden shot a perfect 8-8 FGs in a win at DEN (12/27) en route to game-high 19 points with 10 rebounds and 27 minutes off the bench. (The previous night, Dallas’ other center Erick Dampier had gone 6-6 FGs on his way to a 13-point, 10-rebound double-double.) The double-double was Gooden’s 6th of the season. The game was the 5th of his 7-plus season career in which he was perfect from the floor. In the previous 4 games, Gooden had never scored more than 8 points. In fact, he had made 9 total shots and scored 19 total points in his 4 other 100% shooting games. His 8 makes without a miss match the Mavericks franchise mark. His is 1 of 11 games (10 players) in the NBA this season in which a player scored 15+ points and shot 100% FG.

CENTERPIECE: Erick Dampier is enjoying one of his best seasons since joining the Mavericks in 2004-05. For the year, he averages 8.5 points, 9.8 rebounds, 2.0 blocks (10th in NBA) and 27.2 minutes through 23 starts. Damp’s numbers are his best all-around since averaging 9.2 points, 8.5 rebounds, 1.4 blocks and 27.3 minutes back in ’04-05 (59 games, 56 starts). Over the last 2 games, Dampier is averaging 11.5 points (.818 FG), 9.5 rebounds and 2.0 blocks. He has 10+ rebounds in 4 of his last 5 games (11.6).

REMARKABLE RESERVES: A player off Dallas' bench has led the team in scoring in each of the last 2 games. Drew Gooden scored 19 at DEN (12/27) after Jason Terry led Dallas with 23 vs. MEM (12/26). In that span, the bench is throwing up impressive numbers and outscoring the opposing bench 45.5 ppg to 17.0 ppg. Following is a look at some key individual numbers off the bench of late.

SEVENTH HEAVEN: For the 1st time since the 1999-00 season (4/14/00 vs. SEA, 4/16/00 vs. VAN), 7 Mavericks scored 10+ points in consecutive games (vs. MEM 12/26, at DEN 12/27). In the MEM game, Jason Terry led the Mavericks with 23 points off the bench while Dirk Nowitzki added 20 points. Also scoring 10+ for the Mavs: Erick Dampier (13), JJ Barea and Josh Howard (11), Jason Kidd and Shawn Marion (10). The following evening, the bench once again paced the Mavs' scoring efforts. Drew Gooden led the team with 19 points in 27 minutes off of the bench while Howard (17) and Terry (13) chipped in 30 more points off the bench. Four starters scored 10+ including Barea and Nowitzki (13), Marion (12) and Dampier (10).

PROTECTING WHAT'S THEIRS: Dallas committed just 6 turnovers and allowed only 6 points off those turnovers in a win vs. CLE (12/20). For the season, there have been just 7 teams (8 times) that have committed 6 turnovers or less. Dallas had an NBA season-low 5 turns vs. SA (11/18) and is the only team to have multiple games with 6 or few giveaways. Over the last 3 games, Dallas is averaging just 9.3 turnovers per game.

GOOD NIGHT FROM THE FIELD: The Mavericks shot 50.0% (41-82 FGs, 4-13 3FGs) from the field at DEN (12/27). The game was the 15th of the season (12-3 record) in which the Mavs shot at least 45% FG.

LOTS OF HELP: Dallas recorded 25 assists on 41 made field goals at DEN (12/27) led by Jason Kidd's 9 and 5 from Jason Terry. Dallas improved to 14-1 when dishing 25+ assists. Dallas is 12-3 when Kidd dishes 10+ assists. The Mavericks rank 4th in the league at 23.2 apg.

DIFFERENT KIND OF DOUBLE-DOUBLE: Jason Kidd recorded his 3rd rebounds-assists double-double (2nd in an OT game) of the season with a season-high tying 11 rebounds (11 DR) and 10 assists with 8 points and 4 steals in 43 minutes vs. HOU (12/18). He is the only player in the NBA this season to record a double-double of this variety. Since 2006-07, there have been 18 rebounds-assists double-doubles with Kidd owning 11 of them.

DIRK GOES FOR 30/10 AGAIN: Dirk Nowitzki turned out his 4th 30-point/10-rebound effort of the season with game-highs of 35 points (13-18 FGs, 2-2 3FGs, 7-8 FTs) and 11 rebounds in 39 minutes at OKC (12/16). Dallas is 4-0 in those games. In the 2009 calendar year, Nowitzki has the 4th-most 30/10 games in the NBA and the 3rd most in the 2009-10 season.

NOWITZKI EFFICIENCY: Dirk Nowitzki's 35 points at OKC (12/16) came on a very efficient 72.2% (13-18 FGs, 2-2 3FGs) from the floor. The game was the 2nd of the season for Nowitzki in which he scored at least 30 while shooting at least 71% FG (also 31, 10-14 FGs, .714 at IND 11/27). Nowitzki is the only player in the league to have multiple games of 30 points on 70% FG. There have been 13 such games total this season. He and MIL's Andrew Bogut are the only players this season to record a double-double in games with 30 points and 70% FG.

ANOTHER NIGHT OF 90: For the 6th time this season, the Mavericks shot 90% from the free throw vs. CLE (12/20). Dallas made 19 of their 20 attempts (.950). Tim Thomas (6-7 FTs) missed the lone shot on the evening. The Mavs are 4-2 when shooting such a high percentage from the line and have the most games at 90+ percent. POR (3-1), HOU (2-2) and NY (2-2) are the only other teams to have 3+ such games.

LUCKY #13: Jason Kidd dished 13 assists in a game for the 3rd time this season vs. NO (12/14). He added 13 points for his 4th points-assists double-double (6th overall) of the year. Kidd is 1 of 4 players to record 3 13-assist games this season.

JJ EXCELLENTE: JJ Barea is making his case to stay in the starting lineup next to Jason Kidd. In a starting role that has now lasted 10 straight games, Barea has recorded 3 20-point games (10 for career) and has dished 5+ assists in 4 of those contests. As a starter, Barea is averaging 14.2 points and 4.2 assists in 29.4 minutes. For the season, Barea has 15 games with 4+ assists and 14 10-point outings. He averages career highs of 10.1 points, 2.3 rebounds, 4.0 assists and 25.0 minutes.

CLOSE CALL: Dallas is 9-2 in games decided by 5 points or less. Recently, the Mavs defeated MEM (12/26) 106-101. Since naming Rick Carlisle head coach, the Mavericks are 27-7 in games decided by that margin.

PLETHORA OF POINTS: Dirk Nowitzki has scored 765 points through 30 games this season. Nowitzki, who owns the NBA's 7th-highest scoring average, poured in his 9th 30-point game of the season at OKC (12/16). Nowitzki scored a game-high 35 points (13-18 FGs, 2-2 3FGs, 7-8 FTs) including 24 in the 2nd half. A season ago, Nowitzki had 26 30-point games, tying his career high (also 2005-06). He is on pace for around 24 30-point games this season.

NEARLY-FAULTLESS 4TH: Dirk Nowitzki has missed 1 free throw in the 4th quarter and overtime (3 games). Nowitzki is 58-59 from the line (4-4 in OT) down the stretch. Between the late 4th quarter vs. NO (4/10/09) and the 2:02 mark of the 4th vs. POR (12/22), Nowitzki had made 66 consecutive FTs down the stretch.

PRISTINE 15: Dirk Nowitzki recorded his 20th 15-point half of the season vs. POR (12/22) with 21 points in 23 2nd half minutes. For the season, Nowitzki has 6 20-point performances in a half – all of which have come after halftime. In halves when Nowitzki scores 15+, he shoots a combined 55.2% (132-239 FGs) from the floor, 54.5% (12-22 3FGs) from 3 and 91.0% (101-111 FTs) from the line.

BOUNCING BACK: Since the 2000-01 season (1st of 9 consecutive 50-win seasons), the Mavericks have suffered just 52 losses (in 769 games) of 15+ points. Two of those losses have come this season (82-98 at MEM, 12/4). What's more impressive though, is that the Mavs have won 38 of the games following their 15-point losses (38-14, .731). This season, Dallas is 1-1 in games following 15-point losses. Dallas has lost back-to-back by at least 15 just once in that span (2001-02 season).

HOT SHOT: Dallas poured in another great shooting effort at DEN (12/27). The Mavericks, for the game, shot 50.0% (41-82 FGs) from the floor for the game. Dallas now owns 3 of the top 15 shooting games of the season, including the 2 highest. The Mavs shot 65.5% (55-84 FGs) from the floor at HOU (11/25), 62.4% in a win vs. TOR (11/7) and 58.7% (44-75 FGs) in another win at NJ (12/2). A season ago, DAL just reached the 60% mark at MIA on 1/31/09 (.603). The last the time Mavs had shot that high a clip was when they went 67.7% vs. San Diego Clippers in 1983. The Mavericks are 8-0 when shooting at least 50% FG.

JET & COMPANY: The Mavericks reserves rank 3rd in the NBA in points per game (37.8). Jason Terry contributed his 7th 20-point game off the bench vs. MEM (12/26) and has single-handedly outscored the opposing bench 6 times this season (3-3 record, recently: 23-14 vs. MEM, 12/26). JET is 1 of 6 reserves to have at least 7 20-point games off the bench this season (HOU Landry 14, ATL Crawford 11, NY Harrington 9, DEN Smith, GS Maggette 7). Terry has scored the 2nd-most points of any player off the bench (495) and his 16.5 ppg ranks 4th among all bench players. Terry (10th, 3.4) also ranks in the top 10 assists leaders off the bench.

TOP 40: Dirk Nowitzki recorded his 2nd 40-point game of the season (14th of career, Mavs 10-4 record) vs. SA (11/18). He finished the OT thriller with a season-high 41 points (15-29 FGs, 1-1 3FGs, 10-12 FTs) in 45 minutes. Nowitzki is 1 of 9 players in the NBA to have multiple 40-point games. There have been 35 40-point outings this season.

IN SPITE OF THE RIM: The Mavericks are 7-6 when shooting less than 44% FG (recently, L vs. POR, 12/22). A season ago, Dallas was 6-24 when shooting less than 44%. Dallas also has an NBA-best 4 wins when shooting 40% or less FG (4-5 overall; L vs. POR, 12/22). Dallas won just 1 of 13 games last season when shooting 40% or worse.

MOVING UP THE RANKS: Jason Terry now has 6,132 points as a Maverick and has moved into 7th place all-time among Mavs, passing Sam Perkins (6,766) with 18 points at NJ (12/2). Terry now trails Mavericks player development coach Brad Davis, one of only two players to have his jersey retired by the franchise, for 6th place. If JET sustains his 16.5 points per game pace, look for him to overtake Davis (7,623) by the end of the season.

CRASHING THE BOARDS: Erick Dampier had a monster night on the boards vs. HOU (11/10), coming down with 20 rebounds and a career-high 17 defensive rebounds. The game marked the 8th of his career (2nd with the Mavs) with 20+ rebounds. He has 33 14-rebound performances (6 this season) since joining the Mavs in 2004-05 (recently: 15 vs. POR, 12/22). Dallas is 22-11 when he has 14+ rebounds. Dampier had 6 games with 14+ a season ago.

IRON ERICK: Erick Dampier recorded his 7th double-double of the season with 13 points and 10 rebounds in 35 minutes vs. MEM (12/26). In 2008-09, Dampier had 6 double-doubles for the entire season. When Damp scores 10+ points, odds usually favor the Mavs. Since his arrival in Dallas (2004-05 season), Dampier has recorded 50 double-doubles (39-11 record, .780). When the center scores 10+ points, Dallas is 76-19 (.800). Over the past 4 seasons, Dampier has missed 16 regular season games – including the 8 this season due to an illness.

DIRK and KIDD FOR 3: For his career, Dirk Nowitzki has 1,103 3-pointers and ranks 43rd all-time among NBA players (need 1 3s to overtake Latrell Sprewell for 42nd). In fact, Nowitzki (7,424 rebounds) and teammate Jason Kidd (1,544 3FGs, 7,581 rebs) are 2 of only 3 players in the NBA to have at least 1,000 3s and 7,000 rebounds (also BOS Rasheed Wallace, 1,023 3s and 7,124 rebounds).

APPROACHING 20K: Dirk Nowitzki leads the Mavericks in scoring and ranks 2nd in rebounding this season. After crossing the 19,000 career point mark late last season, Nowitzki is rapidly approaching 20,000 points. Nowitzki now has 19,849 total points. He joins 45 other players to reach the 19,000-point mark and now ranks 34th all-time among NBA scorers, passing John Stockton (19,711) with 36 points vs. CHA (12/12). Stockton was the last player standing between Nowitzki and 20,000 points. Nowitzki ranks 6th among active players in all-time scoring behind Shaquille O'Neal, Kobe Bryant, Allen Iverson, Kevin Garnett and Ray Allen. Nowitzki is followed by Tim Duncan (19,780) and Paul Pierce (19,094).

CLUTCH: Dirk Nowitzki was once again the hero for the Mavericks vs. CHA (12/12) as he boosted them in overtime. Despite struggling from the field throughout the game, the German scored a 6-0 run over the last 1:20 of regulation to force the extra 5:00. Then, with 1.7 seconds remaining in OT, Nowitzki hit a 10-foot fade away to secure the win. The game-winner is Nowitzki's 2nd of the season (also in OT at MIL, 11/16) and the 8th of his career when there are less than 5 seconds remaining. Since 2005-06, Nowitzki owns the most game-winners (put team ahead for good in final 2 seconds) of any player in the NBA. He is followed by MIA's Dwyane Wade (5) and 8 players with 4 each.

TOE THE LINE: The Mavericks, perennially one of the NBA's best free throw shooting clubs, are shooting 79.3% (561-707 FTs) from the line and rank 3rd in NBA behind OKC and DEN. Since the 2000-01 season (first of 9 consecutive 50-win seasons), the Mavericks have shot an NBA-best 80.3% from the line, have led the league in FT shooting in 4 of those seasons (2001-02, 2002-03, 2003-04, 2007-08) and have finished in at least the top 6 each year. In that span, Dirk Nowitzki has shot 87.8% FT (7th in NBA) and has hit 4,548 FTs (4th).

WHAT A FLIRT: Jason Kidd is flirting with his 1st triple-double of the season (currently he has 103 for career trailing Oscar Robertson's 181 and Magic Johnson's 138). The point guard has 9 double-doubles (team-high tying) and has fallen just short of a triple-double in 5 contests.

ALL ALONE IN SECOND PLACE: Jason Kidd now ranks 2nd all-time among the NBA's career assist leaders (10,483 assists). With 7 assists at HOU (11/25/09), he passed Mark Jackson (10,334) for 2nd position. More specifically, Kidd dished his 10,335th assists on an alley-oop lob to rookie Rodrigue Beaubois with 10:52 to play in the 3rd quarter of the HOU game. Kidd now trails only John Stockton (15,806). For the season, the guard averages 9.2 assists (5th among NBA leaders).

STOLE THE SHOW: With 2,253 steals, Jason Kidd now ranks 6th on the NBA's all-time steals list. With 2 steals at SA (11/11/09), Kidd surpassed Clyde Drexler (2,207). The point guard is 55 steals away from taking 5th position from Scottie Pippen (2,307).

TOP 10 LIST: Jason Kidd hit 2 3-pointers vs. MEM (12/26) to move into 7th place all-time on the NBA's 3-point field goals made list with 1,543 (surpassing Tim Hardaway, 1,542 3FGs). For his career, he has 1,544 3-pointers. With 3 more 3-pointers, he will move into 6th place (Eddie Jones, 1,546). He can be found on several other NBA Top 10 lists (2nd at 10,474 career assists, 6th at 9.2 apg; 3rd with 103 triple-doubles; 6th with 2,252 steals).

A STRING OF STARTS: Jason Kidd has the 7th-most starts in NBA history and has started 98.9% (1125-1138) of the games he has played. Only 2 other players with 1,000 career games have started a higher percentage than Kidd (Karl Malone: 99.7%, 1471-1476; Shaquille O'Neal: 99.2%, 1134-1143). Kidd ranks T-36th in career games.

BACK-TO-BACK IT UP: Dallas finished the 9th of 20 back-to-backs at DEN (12/27). The Mavericks have 4 more back-to-backs than last year. Seven begin on the road and conclude at home, seven are on the road and six are home-away. Twelve of Dallas' back-to-backs occur in the first half of the season. Dallas is 7-2 (.778) in the first game of a back-to-back and 5-4 (.556) in the second game.

HOW THE MAVS WERE BUILT: Of the 15 players currently on the roster, 11 are former first round draft picks (Erick Dampier, Drew Gooden, Josh Howard, Kris Humphries, Jason Kidd, Shawn Marion, Dirk Nowitzki, Jason Terry, Tim Thomas, Shawn Williams, Rodrigue Beaubois). Seven were top 10 picks (Dampier, Gooden, Kidd, Marion, Nowitzki, Terry, Thomas). Kidd holds the honor of being the highest drafted Maverick (second overall by Dallas in 1994). Four Mavericks were undrafted (J.J. Barea, Matt Carroll, Quinton Ross, James Singleton).

EVERYTHING IS BIGGER IN TEXAS: On 10/30/08, Dallas was awarded the 2010 NBA All-Star Game (Feb. 14, 2010). In a joint venture between Mavericks owner Mark Cuban and Dallas Cowboys owner Jerry Jones, and following the mantra that "everything is bigger in Texas," the All-Star Game will be played at the new Dallas Cowboys Stadium in Arlington, which will have a seating capacity of over 80,000 fans. This collaboration between the NBA, and the ownership groups of the Mavericks and Cowboys, will afford Mavericks season ticket holders a chance to partake in the NBA All-Star Game. The T-Mobile Rookie Challenge and NBA All-Star Saturday Night will take place at American Airlines Center. Dallas last hosted All-Star festivities in 1986.

ELITE COMPANY: The Mavericks are just the fourth franchise (five times total) since the NBA went to an 82-game schedule in 1967 to have at least nine consecutive 50-win seasons. Here is a run down of the teams to accomplish this feat:

1. Los Angeles Lakers 12 consecutive seasons (from 1979-80 to 1990-91)
2. Boston Celtics 10 consecutive seasons (from 1958-59 to 1967-68)
San Antonio Spurs 10 consecutive seasons (from 1999-00 to 2008-09)
3. Boston Celtics 9 consecutive seasons (from 1979-80 to 1987-88)
Dallas Mavericks 9 consecutive seasons (from 2000-01 to 2008-09)

JUST THE TWO OF US: The Mavericks and Spurs are the only two teams to have won 50+ games in each of the past nine seasons. Here's a look at the records of the Mavericks and Spurs over the past nine seasons:

20,000 MANIAACS: The Mavericks have sold out 333 consecutive home games, which is an NBA-best sellout streak. The listed capacity for AAC is 19,200 but that can be surpassed because of attendance in the suites. The streak started on 12/15/01. Dallas has sold out an additional 44 playoff games during that same stretch. Since moving into American Airlines Center (2001-02 season), the Mavericks have posted a home mark of 274-67 (.804). Dallas has sold out all 41 games in each of the past seven seasons.

HEAD COACH RICK CARLISLE

Regular Season Coaching Record: 353-252 (.583); Playoff Coaching Record: 35-37 (.486)

Rick Carlisle became the ninth coach in franchise history on May 9, 2008. He joined the Mavericks after spending six seasons, with Detroit and Indiana, as a head coach. Most recently, Carlisle served as an ESPN studio analyst during the 2007-08 NBA season.

In seven seasons as a head coach, Carlisle has led his team to the postseason on six occasions.

Carlisle began his head coaching career with Detroit. During his two-season tenure, the Pistons won 61.0% of their games (100-64) to go with two Central Division championships and one trip to the Eastern Conference Finals. Following his first season as head coach, Carlisle earned the NBA's Coach of the Year award in 2002.

Carlisle joined Indiana as head coach on Sept. 2, 2003. In his first year, Carlisle led the Pacers to the NBA's best record (61-21), the most victories in franchise history, the best winning percentage in franchise history and a Central Division championship. He also led the Pacers to the 2004 Eastern Conference Finals where they eventually lost to the Pistons. Carlisle, including his previous two seasons with Detroit, became the first coach since Pat Riley to win 50 games and division championships in each of his first three seasons as head coach. Overall, Carlisle earned a 181-147 (.552) regular season record in Indiana and led the team to three consecutive postseason appearances before stepping down following the 2006-07 campaign.

Carlisle began his coaching career in 1989 as an assistant with the New Jersey Nets. In five seasons with the Nets, he had the opportunity to work under Hall of Fame coaching legends Bill Fitch and Chuck Daly. Carlisle then moved on to Portland, where he spent three seasons as an assistant under P.J. Carlesimo before joining former teammate Larry Bird's staff in Indiana during the summer of 1997.
