- **TONIGHT'S KEY RUN:** Dallas led 112-108 with 2:23 to go in overtime. Portland then went on a 6-0 run through the 44.9 second mark to take a 114-112 lead.

## NOTES

- Josh Howard scored 14 2<sup>nd</sup> quarter points – the most he's had in a quarter since scoring 13 in the 3<sup>rd</sup> period of the season finale vs. HOU last year (4/15/08). He finished the game with 17 points and 5 rebounds in 26 minutes.
- JJ Barea came down with a season-high 7 rebounds to go with 13 points and 3 assists in 26 minutes. His previous high was 6 rebounds (2 times)
- Dallas' bench, led by Howard and Barea, outscored POR's bench 44-18.
- Dirk Nowitzki, who averages 6.7 4<sup>th</sup> quarter points (4<sup>th</sup> among all NBA players), scored 14 points (5-8 FGs, 4-4 FTs) in the 4<sup>th</sup> period tonight. He finished the game with team-bests of 28 points (9-19 FGs, 10-10 FTs) and 9 rebounds in 45 minutes.
- Jason Kidd recorded his 14<sup>th</sup> double-double (team-high) of the season with 10 points (4-8 FGs, 2-5 3FGs), 4 rebounds, 10 assists and 1 steal in 40 minutes. It is his 11<sup>th</sup> game with a points-assists double-double.
- Eduardo Najera saw his first action since the Jan. 11 trade that brought him back to Dallas. He had not played in 9 games since the transaction. Najera played 2 minutes and scored 3 points in his debut.
- Andre Miller scored a career-high 52 points (22-31 FGs, 1-1 3FGs, 7-8 FTs) with 5 rebounds, 2 assists and 2 steals in 42 minutes. His previous season-high was 28 at BOS (1/22). His previous career-high was 37 (2 times). Miller is the 6<sup>th</sup> player in Dallas history to score 50+ points on the Mavericks. It marks the 3<sup>rd</sup>-best individual effort against the franchise. His 22 FGMs mark an American Airlines Center record (previous was 20 by PHO's Steve Nash (20-28) on in a playoff game 5/15/05).
- The Mavericks played overtime for the 6<sup>th</sup> time this season (3-3) while the Blazers went into OT for the 4<sup>th</sup> time this year (1-3).
- Tonight's attendance was 20,078 fans (19,200 capacity). The Mavs have sold out 339 consecutive regular season games at AAC. Dallas currently owns the longest running sellout streak in the NBA. Dallas has sold out all 41 games in each of the past seven seasons.
