- **TONIGHT'S KEY RUN:** Miami led 77-76 with 5:29 to play in the 4th quarter. Dallas then went on a 14-5 run to take a 90-82 lead with 51.7 seconds remaining.

NOTES

- Caron Butler (14) and Dirk Nowitzki (10) combined for 24 of Dallas' first 25 points through the 8:23 mark of the 2nd quarter. Brendan Haywood converted 1 free throw in that span (34.3 seconds left in 1st quarter).
- Butler recorded his 1st 20-point game since joining the Mavericks. He scored 16 1st half points (6-10 FGs, 4-6 FTs) and then added 4 more late in the 4th quarter. He added 4 rebounds, 3 assists and 1 steal in 42 minutes. He owns 17 20-point games for the season.
- Haywood posted his 14th double-double (1st since the trade) with 11 points and 11 rebounds (5 OR). He added a season-high 4 assists and 1 block in 39 minutes.
- Jason Kidd recorded his 17th double-double (14th with points-assists) with 21 points (5-8 FGs, 3-5 3FGs, season-highs 8-9 FTs), 5 rebounds, 11 assists and 3 steals in 40 minutes. The game is his 2nd of the season with 20 points. Over the last 3 wins, Kidd averages 4.7 steals.
- DeShawn Stevenson made his home debut and his second appearance in a game since joining the Mavericks. He played 25 seconds at the end of the 1st half.
- Dallas held Miami to an opponent season-low points for a quarter with 12 in the 3rd. The previous low was 13 by NY (3rd) on 1/24/10.
- Dallas' bench scored a season-low 6 points (4 by Jason Terry). The previous low was 15 vs. ATL (12/5/09).
- For the 6th time this season (2nd consecutive home game), all 5 Mavericks starters scored 10+ points led by Dirk Nowitzki's 28 (10-21 FGs, 8-8 FTs) and followed by Kidd, Butler, Haywood and Shawn Marion. Dallas is 5-1 when all starters score 10+.
- The Mavericks won 3 straight games for their longest winning streak since winning 5 straight between vs. PHO (12/8) and at OKC (12/16). Dallas hadn't won consecutive home games since vs. OKC (1/15) and vs. MIL (1/26).
- Miami's Daequan Cook scored a season-high 22 points (8-16 FGs, 3-5 3FGs, 3-3 FTs) in 34 minutes off the bench.
- Tonight's attendance was 20,328 fans (19,200 capacity). The Mavs have sold out 343 consecutive regular season games at AAC. Dallas currently owns the longest running sellout streak in the NBA. Dallas has sold out all 41 games in each of the past seven seasons.
