- **TONIGHT'S KEY RUN:** Dallas led 106-104 with 2:35 to play. Minnesota then went on a 13-2 run through the 22.3 second mark to secure the win.

NOTES

- Dirk Nowitzki came off the bench for the 1st time since a loss vs. SA (12/14/99). He finished that game with 8 points in 29 minutes. Tonight, Nowitzki checked into the game at the 6:48 mark of the 1st quarter. He finished the game with 21 points (6-15 FGs, 9-10 FTs), 8 rebounds, 4 assists and 37 minutes.
- Rodrigue Beaubois scored a career-high 17 points (6-10 FGs, 4-5 3FGs, 1-2 FTs) and also set career marks in FGM (tied) and 3FGM. He added 1 rebound, 2 assists and 2 steals in 24 minutes off the bench.
- Jason Kidd had 4 steals tonight after coming up with 6 on Wednesday vs. GS. He also scored 17 points with 6 rebounds, 7 assists and 2 blocks in 37 minutes.
- JJ Barea registered his 1st DNP-CD of the season. He had appeared in each of Dallas' previous 49 games.
- Jonny Flynn led 5 MIN starters in double figures with 19 points and 7 assists in 33 minutes.
- Minnesota snapped a 13-game losing streak to the Mavs that dated back to 1/4/06 (L 78-91 in MIN).
- Tonight's attendance was 20,034 fans (19,200 capacity). The Mavs have sold out 341 consecutive regular season games at AAC. Dallas currently owns the longest running sellout streak in the NBA. Dallas has sold out all 41 games in each of the past seven seasons.
