- **TONIGHT'S KEY RUN:** Dallas led 47-44 with 2:58 to go in the 2<sup>nd</sup> quarter. The Mavs then went on a 21-7 run through the 7:27 mark of the 3<sup>rd</sup> period to extend to a 68-51 lead.

## NOTES

- JJ Barea (sore left ankle) did not dress.
- Dirk Nowitzki recorded his 1<sup>st</sup> triple-double (2<sup>nd</sup> of career) and 17<sup>th</sup> 30-point game with 34 points (7-17 FGs, 4-5 3FGs, 16-17 FTs), 10 rebounds, 10 assists and 1 block in 37 minutes. His 10 assists, 4 3-pointers and 16 FTs are season-highs.
- Nowitzki's last triple-double came vs. MIL (2/6/08) with 34 points, 10 rebounds and 12 assists.
- Shawn Marion recorded his 2<sup>nd</sup> 20-point game of the season with 21 points (9-13 FGs, 3-3 FTs), 2 rebounds, 2 assists and 2 steals in 29 minutes.
- Dallas' last 3 wins have come by an average of 15.7 points.
- Jason Kidd is averaging 10.0 assists over his last 4 games after having 10 tonight with 8 points, 6 rebounds and 3 steals.
- Dallas improved to 17-2 when coming away with 10+ steals (10 tonight led by 3 each from Kidd and Beaubois).
- Brendan Haywood blocked 4 shots tonight for his 4<sup>th</sup> game as a Maverick (14<sup>th</sup> of season) with 4+ blocks.
- Dallas hit 21-24 FTs tonight. In the previous 5 games, the Mavs had not attempted more than 19 free throws and had not made more than 14 in that span.
- Dallas is now 10-1 when hitting 10+ 3-pointers. Led by 4 from Nowitzki, the Mavs were 12-22 (.545) from beyond-the-arc.
- With 27 points, JR Smith led 3 Nuggets in double figures off then bench. Ty Lawson and Joey Graham also had 10 each. Dallas is 5-5 when 3 opposing reserves score 10+.
- Dallas has now secured a 2-1 series win over Denver.
- Tonight's attendance was 20,085 fans (19,200 capacity). The Mavs have sold out 354 consecutive regular season games at AAC. Dallas currently owns the longest running sellout streak in the NBA. Dallas has sold out all 41 games in each of the past seven seasons.
